# University of Saint Francis Course Schedule

Main Campus; Summer Term: May 8-August 25, 2017

All currently enrolled students have two ways to register for classes. Registration can be completed from any computer with Internet access (anywhere in the world) on *Cougar Connection* or a student can register in person at the Registrar's Office.

## Option 1: Web Registration

A student must have a network login (username and password) to use web registration. Please use the following steps:

1. Review the course schedule located on the USF website at [www.sf.edu](http://www.sf.edu) on the Registrar's homepage and in Cougar Connection. The course schedule is subject to change. Changes are updated daily, and the most current schedule is available in the Cougar Connection Course Search feature.
2. Select the desired courses and make sure they are a program requirement or elective in your major.
3. Make an appointment with your advisor. If you do not know who your advisor is, contact the Registrar's Office or your academic department, or view your advisor's name posted on the Student Academics tab in Cougar Connection. Your advisor will:
  - Help you determine the courses for which you need to register
  - Complete and sign a paper registration form with you
  - Grant Registration Clearance
4. Find the first day that you can register from the registration schedule indicated in the days and times chart printed below. The number of credit hours **earned in previous** semesters determines the day you can first register. You can register at 7:00am on that first day and 24 hours a day after that until the Friday of the first week of the semester for 16-week courses. Web registration closes on the Friday of the first week of the semester at 5pm for 16-week courses.
5. While logged into Cougar Connection, at the *Students* Tab, click on the *Academic Information* link and choose the *Course Search* link to begin the online registration process.
6. If you want to register on the web but want to walk through it with some assistance, help will be located at the Vann Library Help Desk in the Pope John Paul II Center during normal business hours. You can register online with assistance by contacting the Registrar's Office in the Pope John Paul II Center, room 207, or call 1-260-399-7700 ext 6520, or email [bkrieg@sf.edu](mailto:bkrieg@sf.edu).
7. **New graduate students** who are registering at USF for the first-time should contact the program director in the academic department of their major before registering for courses.

## Option 2: Traditional Walk-up Registration

A student must have a completed registration form, signed by their advisor, to register in person.

1. Review the course schedule located on the USF website at [www.sf.edu](http://www.sf.edu) on the Registrar's homepage and in Cougar Connection. The course schedule is subject to change. Changes are updated daily, and the most current schedule is available in the Cougar Connection Course Search feature.
2. Select the desired courses and make sure they are a program requirement or elective in your major.
3. Make an appointment with your advisor. If you do not know who your advisor is, contact the Registrar's Office or your academic department, or view your advisor's name posted on the Student Academics tab in Cougar Connection. Your advisor will:
  - Help you determine the courses for which you need to register

- Complete and sign a paper registration form with you
  - Grant Registration Clearance
4. Find the first day that you can register from the registration schedule indicated in the days and times chart printed below. The number of credit hours **earned in previous** semesters determines the day you can first register. Thereafter, you can register in person at the Registrar's Office during normal business hours. Registration is closed at the end of the drop/add period.

- Official withdrawal after the drop/add period deadline and before the end date of a Summer Term course results in a grade of "W" which is indicated on the permanent record.

## **STUDENT ACCOUNT REGISTRATION AGREEMENT**

**All students who register, by doing so, agree to the following policies:**

### **COURSE REGISTRATION**

- Students are responsible for planning an academic program that meets current requirements, including the required sequencing of classes.
- Students are responsible for meeting with their advisor before they register for classes to insure that intended courses meet a program requirement or elective.
- Students are responsible for the actions taken to register for courses, to drop courses, or add courses. This includes actions taken by registering on the web or in person at the Registrar's Office.

## **BILLING AND PAYMENT PROCEDURES**

- Billing statements will be mailed to the student's legal/permanent address maintained by the Registrar's Office.
- Payment of any balance not covered by released financial aid at the start of the academic term is due in the Business Office by the published due date.
- After this due date, students with a past due balance will be assessed late payment fees.

## **UNPAID PAST DUE STUDENT ACCOUNT BALANCES**

- Continuing unpaid past due balances are subject to late payment fees and penalty or interest.
- Students are responsible for any and all collection costs and attorney fees associated with the collection of unpaid balances.
- Student accounts will be assessed a 25% collection fee on the unpaid account balance prior to being turned over to a collection agency.

## **FINANCIAL AID**

- Students are responsible for notifying the Office of Financial Aid when the credit hours enrolled does not correspond to the enrollment status indicated on the Financial Aid Award Notification.
- Students dropping or withdrawing from courses should notify the Office of Financial Aid to determine if this action requires an adjustment to the student's financial aid funding.
- Students are responsible to reply to request for additional information in a timely fashion. An incomplete financial aid file will result in a delay of financial aid funding being processed and applied to the student's business office account.
- Students must have a completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on file with the Office of Financial Aid to be reviewed for financial aid eligibility.

- Students who wish to be reviewed for summer aid options must complete a Financial Aid Summer Request form. These forms are available at the Office of Financial Aid.

I understand and agree to the assessment of late payment fees, penalty or interest, and collection costs for unpaid past due balances.
